

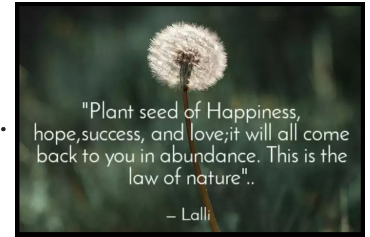

## VOCABULARY BINGO

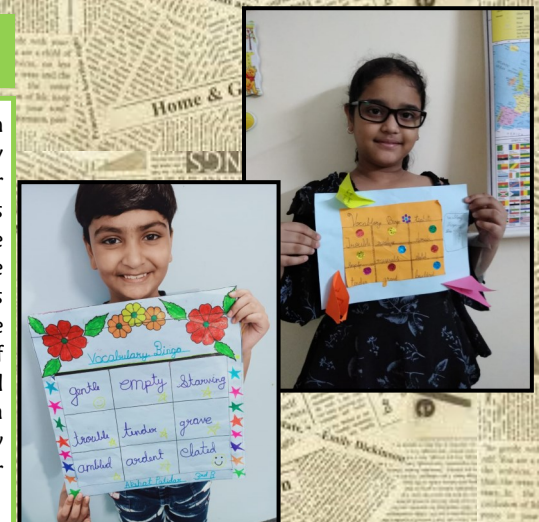

21<sup>st</sup> of July 2020. The students were provided with a list of vocabulary to prepare a sheet of tickets with 9 words of their choice from the list.

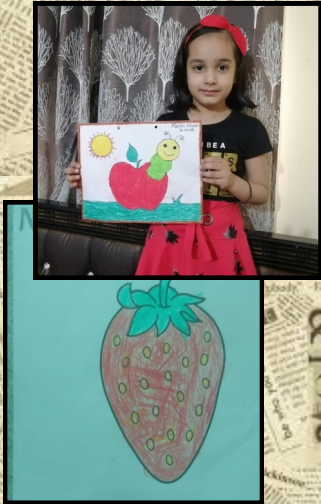
The activity was conducted online. It was identical to house game in which words were announced in place of numbers. The students pinned the

## DRAWING AND COLOURING COMPETITION

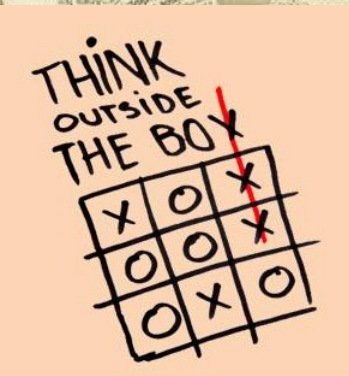

 "Best out of waste" activity was conducted for class 1 & 2 Students. The focus of the activity was to create a platform to exhibit their creative talent.

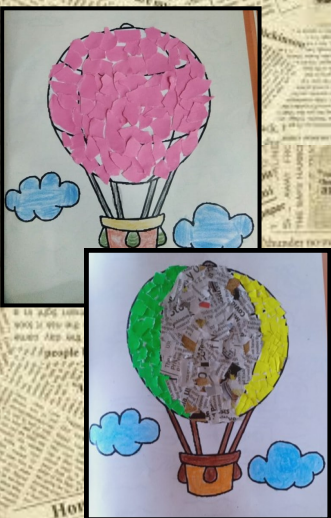
The children participated earnestly in the fun-filled activity and came up with innovative

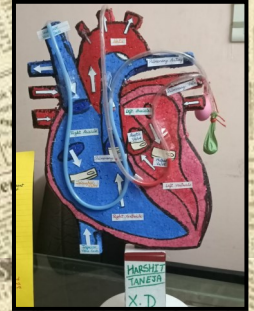
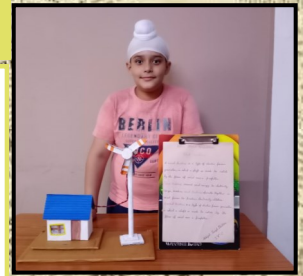


## SCIENCE MODEL COMPETITION

 The students were awarded an e-certificate in the respective levels for the first, second and third categories.

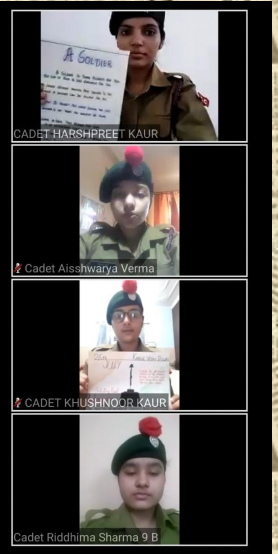

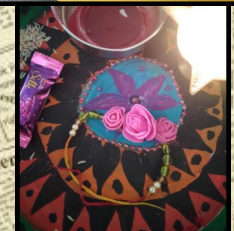


## RAKSHABANDHAN CRAFT
