A magical fiesta was presented by the students, showcasing their spectacular talents through captivating performances.

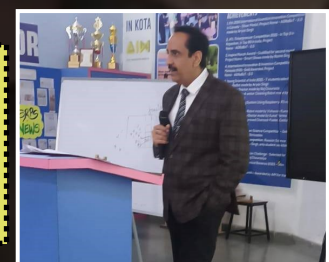
The Scholastic and Co - Scholastic Achievers were awarded for their outstanding accomplishments.
