Wishing you a year full of knowledge, creativity, and accomplishments. Let's make this journey inspiring and meaningful together.

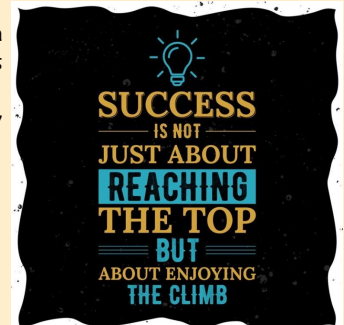
